Summer Terms 2017

We are delighted to offer a wide range of extra-curricular clubs for the summer term. Some are run by members of staff, and others by external providers, who charge for their time, knowledge and skill. Please let us know by completing the form towards the end of this booklet which two clubs your child would like to participate in. You will be informed by letter at the beginning of the Summer term which club(s) we are able to offer them.

If your child is offered a place in a paid club, please be aware that our payment policy is that :

- All payments must be made via Parent Pay – we regret that we cannot accept cash or cheques for Clubs payments;
- Payment must be received before the first meeting of the club;
- Payment secures a child's place within the club for the entire term and refunds will not be offered to parents who choose to withdraw their child to take part in sporting or other arranged events.



Ballroom Dancing (Years 3 – 6)

Every child in Key Stage 2 has now experienced ballroom dancing. Now they can take it to the next level. Step by Step Dance School is offering expert tuition to the children in years 3 – 6 and will look to build on the fun and skills that have been learned during their PE lessons.

Note this club costs £35 per child for the two terms.

Board Games (Years 3 & 4)

Miss Coleman is looking for children who enjoy working with others to enjoy a variety of board games.

Choir (Years 3 – 6)

Our Primary Choir runs for the whole year with their existing members. Anyone who is interested in joining the Choir in September should speak with Mrs Murphy or Mrs Hussain.

There is no need to select this as one of the clubs that you wish to join.

Craft (Years 1 & 2)

Mrs Simmonds is looking for children who enjoy art, design and technology. This club will be using a variety of tools and techniques to produce a range of work using a wide variety of materials.

Dodgeball (Years 2 – 6)

During this club, the children will learn the rules and skills of this exciting game. The aim of the game is for players on one team to try to eliminate players on another by hitting them with an inflated ball, and as such, this club is particularly physical.

Note this club costs £30 per child for the two terms.

Football Club and Girls' Football (Years 2 – 6)

Junior Foxes will continue to run our football club – they have strong ties with Leicester FC, which has led to some of their members being scouted for Elite division clubs.

Note this club costs £30 per child for the two terms.

Football (Year R AND Key Stage 1)

Fun introduction to football, learning the essential basic skills and rules. Reception children's club will be held indoors and they do not need special equipment; Key Stage 1 children's club will be held outdoors and they must have shin pads and football boots; they may also wear a football strip of their choice if they would like to.

Note this club costs £ 30

Green Fingers (Gardening Club) (Years 1 & 2)

Mrs Barnes is looking for enthusiastic children in Years 1 and 2 to look after our lovely garden area behind our Key Stage 1 classrooms. Exciting news – birds are nesting in our garden area!

Gymnastics (Key Stages 1 & 2)

We will continue to utilise our fabulous instructor from the MAB Gymnastics Academy to offer gymnastics for our Key Stage 1 & 2 classes.

Note this club costs £ 30 per child for the two terms.

Hotshots Basketball (Years 2 – 6)

Hotshots basketball club is the perfect way to match the fitness benefits of basketball with the enjoyment that comes from playing. Hotshots' philosophy is to make every session as much fun as possible with games, shoot-outs and drills to test the skills and the stamina of all our club members in an environment that keeps a smile on their faces. This club runs on two different days, so please specify the day on which you wish to attend. ***Due to swimming lessons, pupils in Year 4 should only request membership of the Friday club, please.***

Note this club costs £30 per child for the two terms.

IPad Club (Years 3 & 4)

In this club, children will explore apps for use in learning, and also apps for creativity and fun. They will explore what currently sits on our iPads and also investigate new apps that children have discovered in their use of technology at home. Each week will have a different focus. ***Children who have previously attended should not re-apply, as session content will be repeated from term to term.***

Let's Get Cooking (Years 3 & 4)

Sessions will run on a **fortnightly** basis, for two hours finishing at 5:15 p.m. All children participating in this club need to be committed to staying for the entire duration to allow for cooking times. Details about the session dates will be given to club members once the club begins.

Note this club costs £20 per child for the two terms: this is to cover the ingredients that will be used during the club sessions.

Multiskills (Years 1 – 4)

The club offers children the chance to develop their physical literacy taught through fun games from Professional Team Fundamentals instructors in a safe environment. The sessions will focus on core skills such as balance, coordination and agility. There will also be opportunities to work towards the Team Fundamentals player of the month awards.

Note this club costs £ 40 per child for the two terms.

Netball (Years 4 – 6)

Miss Daniells and Miss Iles will coach this club, which is for invited members only. We hope to develop the love of the game and improve teamwork through fun, skills based sessions.

There is no need to select this as one of the clubs that you wish to join.

Songbirds (Years 1 & 2)

This is our choir for pupils in Key Stage 1. Membership is currently closed until September

Story Telling (Years 1 & 2)

Each week Mrs Nimmo will focus on a different story, which will involve fun activities

Street Dance (Years 1 – 6)

The classes offer children the chance to learn a variety of street dance techniques and skills taught through choreographed routines and fun learning games from hip hop and commercial genres. uDance teachers promote an emphasis on creativity and improvisation, whilst encouraging a healthy lifestyle within a fun and safe environment. Every four weeks there will be an “uDancer of the Month” award presented in class.

Note this club costs £ 40 per child for the two terms.

Street Hockey (Years 2 – 6)

The object of the game is to score more goals than the opposing team by shooting the ball or puck into the opposing team’s net. Street hockey in its purest form is generally played under the same guidelines as normal hockey, but players may find it even more free-flowing.

Note this club costs £30 per child for the two terms.

Yoga (Years 2 & 3)

Mrs Millar will be leading a small group in the art of relaxation and flexibility. The children will use yoga mats to practise their stretches with a selection of relaxing background music. *Please note we have changed the Years that this club is open to this term.*
